Other Lectionary readings for the day

2 Samuel 7:1-11, 16 Having already done much for David, the Lord still takes the initiative. David's family and influence will continue through his house, which will become part of God's plan to work through the chosen people.

Psalm 89:1-4, 19-26 The Psalm testifies to God's unconditional covenant to David. God will keep God's promise and not lie to David (v35), even if his sons commit offenses.

Romans 16:25-27 In a closing doxology, Paul interprets God's act in Christ as continuous with God's mystery that has slowly been revealed through the scripture. This revelation can strengthen the faith of the church
