Luke 24:44-53 Only by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit can our unbelieving minds and hearts come to believe the scriptures. Jesus opens the minds of his followers so they can truly see and believe everything written about him in the Old Testament.

Psalm 47 An expression of the kingship of God, this psalm recognises YHWH on the throne over heaven and earth. God has gone up with a shout of praise to the throne after the conquests of David.

Ephesians 1:15-23 Through the power of Christ the faithful believers have obtained an inheritance of salvation and redemption, sealed by the Holy Spirit.
