Lectionary readings for the day

1 Samuel 17:1a, (4-11,19-23), 32-49 God enables David to defeat the Philistine giant David. **Psalm 9:9-20** This individual lament presupposes that the psalmist is in dire trouble. However, the psalmist remembers that God is a stronghold for the oppressed, that God remembers the needy, and that God does not forsake those who trust God.

2 Corinthians 6:1-13 Although glitzy super-apostles told the community that Pau's sufferings showed that he could not be an authentic apostle, Paul insists that God's support in suffering is proof of his authority.
