#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1 What do you think? Was it right for Jesus to test Philip by asking him to feed 5000 people?
- 2 Is there a time when you felt God was asking something that was beyond your abilities? How did you respond?
- 3 Are you a church who "punches above its weight" who will try things which seem beyond you by trusting in the power of God?
- 4 What do you think non-church people think when they hear that Christians 'step out in faith?

## Lectionary readings for the day

**2 Samuel 11:1-15** Sin begets more sin. After King David has taken Uriah's wife, Bathsheba, he tries to cover up his misdeed. Uriah's faithfulness as a soldier unfortunately leads to David planning his murder.

**Psalm 14** This psalm attests to humanity's proclivity for sin. The psalmist notes that there is not even one individual that does right. Yet the Lord will still restore God's people.

**Ephesians 3:14-21** The writer prays for his Christian converts to live up to their created intent – that is, to display the love of Christ in their actions toward their fellow persons.
