Lectionary readings for the day

Psalm 45:1-2,6-9 God's enduring love lavishes the righteous with enduring favour, anointing them with "the oil of joy", exceeding their expectation

Mark 7:1-8,14-15,21-23 Jesus reminds the Pharisees and scribes that the source of our relationship with God is from the heart. True worship – as well as "evil thoughts" – emerge from the interior of a person. On the other hand, they "ignore God's commandment while holding on to rules created by humans".
