Discussion Starters

- 1** What was something in the sermon you found affirming? Challenging?
- 2** How do you prepare for Christmas?
- 3** Spend a moment to imagine a gift of God coming to you that promises to transform your life in ways that lift great burdens. How does that gift feel?
- 4** How could we prepare for the coming of God's gift?

Lectionary readings for the day

Malachi 3:1-4 Malachi prophesies the coming of a messenger to prepare the way before the Lord. But his coming will be hard to endure, as he will purify Israel as a refiner's fire.

Luke 1:68-79 Zechariah, father of John, praises God who has acted to fulfill the ancient promises to Israel. He prophesies the coming work of John who will go before the "dawn from heaven" (v 78).

Philippians 1:3-11 Paul thanks God for the Philippians who have supported him in proclaiming the gospel and now in prison. He prays that their love may overflow so they may be blameless on the day of Christ.
