1 Samuel 2:18-20,26 Samuel, like the boy Jesus in today's Gospel, remained in the temple as his parents returned home. Unlike Mary and Joseph, Samuel's parents had agreed to allow their son to remain in temple service. Like Jesus, young Samuel grew in the estimation od God and people.

Psalm 148 The Psalmist calls all creation, including young men and women along with the old, to praise the Lord.

Colossians 3:12-17 Paul encourages his listeners to put on Christ and live with one another in peace. Related to the first reading and the Gospel, he asks us to teach and admonish one another in the spirit of true wisdom.
