Lectionary readings for the day

Exodus 34:29-35 Moses returns to the mountain top carrying the 2 tablets of the law, his face shining from his encounter with God. The Israelites and their leaders feared this. From then on Moses veiled his face after he finished speaking and unveiled it to return to the presence of God.

Psalms 99 The psalmist sings of the people trembling before God. God, enthroned on the holy mountain, is to be praised and exalted.

2 Corinthians 3:12 - 4:2 Through Christ we are able to see the glory of God with unveiled faces. This glory is the glory that is our very transformation by the work of the Spirit of God.
