**Psalm 32:1-8** There is nothing better than forgiveness – being restored to right relationship, having something that was broken made whole again.

**2 Corinthians 5:1-16-21** Forgiveness, or reconciliation, is not just getting a second chance. It is becoming a whole new thing – a whole new life, person, and creation. Having received this new life, we are commissioned, invited, and entrusted to share it with others.
