Discussion Starters

- **1** How do you react to the idea that the Easter message is about God's extravagance?
- 2 Where in your life, have you found God's extravagant love bringing new life, hope and transformation?
- **3** Where in your congregation, can you see evidence of God's extravagant love, life, hope and transformation?
- 4 How do our lives, and the life of our congregation bear witness to Christ's transforming presence in our community?

Lectionary readings for the day

Isaiah 65:17-25 God creates new heavens and a new earth where there is joyful and abundant life for God's faithful servants. This alternate reality is a future and yet present promise.

Psalm 118:1-2,14-24 The psalmist jubilantly celebrates the salvation of God, and God's deliverance from death to life.

1 Corinthians15:19-26 The Resurrection, according to Paul, is the first scene in the final and climactic act of God's drama to redeem the world. The Resurrection creates hope in the believers in this life and for the life to come.
