Focus Readings John 16:12-15

Message 8 minutes 5 seconds “The Triune God”

Discussion Starters

1. Do you agree about what the speaker said about trinity, particularly trinity in relation with ‘community’ and ‘relationship’?
2. Think about a moment when you felt the Triune God worked in your life/life of your congregation?
3. How do we build a better community and remain a healthy and close relationship with one another as reflected in God’s Trinitarian love?
4. How do we express God’s community-building love in our neighbourhood and our streets?

Lectionary readings for the day

Proverbs 8:1-4, 22-31 Wisdom is personified and portrayed as a living creation of YHWH. We are first called to listen to Wisdom and wisdom’s close connection to the created order.

Psalms 8 Directs us to the work of creation, to its grandeur and beauty, and to the comparative smallness of humanity. Yet God has given humanity something special that even so sets us apart.

Romans 5:1-5 A classic Trinitarian text, Romans 5 shows us the three divine Persons working in concert to make us new creations, justified by grace and engulfed by the anointing of God’s love.
