Lectionary readings for the day

Amos 7: 7-17 Called by God, Amos has gone from herding sheep and goats to challenging King Jeroboam and the people of Israel. God has held up a plumb line, Amos tells them, and found the nation warped.

Psalm 82 God confronts the nations of the earth with their sins and misdeeds. They have ignored the poor, favouring the wealthy. The divine judge declares they must give justice to the weak and orphans and rescue the needy.

Colossians 1: 1-14 Paul praises the saints in Colossae for their faithfulness to the gospel and their love of God. They are “producing fruit in every good work” (v10). He prays they will be strong and, with God’s help, able to endure the challenges that may lie ahead.
