#### Lectionary readings for the day

Amos 8:1-12 God shows Amos a basket of summer fruit as a visual image of Israel's end.
Songs will be turned into wailing and feasts into mourning because the people have ignored
God and oppressed the poor and needy. They are to prepare for famine of God's word.
Psalm 52 The psalmist reminds the wicked who are only trusting their wealth, their lying, and love of evil that they will be subject to God's judgement. Our trust should be in the love of God.

**Luke 10:38-42** Jesus' friend Martha complains that her sister Mary, has chosen to study at his feet rather than helping her in the kitchen. What is the better part? It is not to worry about worldly chores, but focus on the word of God.
