Focus Readings Luke 12:34-40

**Message** 9 minutes 15 seconds "Where your treasure is, there your heart is also."

#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. I wonder what you would find easy to give away or do without?
- 2. What would you find very hard to give away?
- 3. Many of us treat our church buildings like treasured possessions, so we hold onto them when no longer needed. Why might that be?
- 4. If you were to give your buildings to those in need, who might it be?

#### Lectionary readings for the day

**Isaiah 1:1, 10-20** The opening message of the prophet Isaiah is quite clear: God is most angry. While holding out the possibility of forgiveness, God sees a people whose violent and unjust actions give the lie to their empty worship.

**Hebrews 11:1-3, 8-16** What does it mean to live by faith? After presenting us with a definition of faith – things hoped for but not seen – the author presents us with portraits of those who lived faithful lives. They stepped out in faith but did not see the promise fulfilled. **Psalm 50:1-8, 22-23** God, the mighty one, is our judge, and no other. And it is God who

testifies against us.
