Lectionary readings for the day

Exodus 20:1-4, 7-9, 12-20 In this abbreviated version of the Ten Commandments, we learn the basics of God's law. Yet even the law is framed by the liberating grace of the God "who bought you out of Egypt" (v2).

Psalm 19 Here, the psalmist hymns the same Sinai God whose glory is disclosed both in creation and law.

Matthew 21:33-46 In this judgement parable, Jesus discloses that God's Kingdom will be given to those who see the son as the rightful heir, not as a stone to be rejected – as do the official interpreters of the law.
