Exodus 33:12-23 Moses wants the Lord to assure him and the people of God’s presence in their journey. God agrees, yet God’s glorious presence cannot be managed or understood on purely human grounds.

Psalms 99 This hymn celebrates God’s kingship, and yet acknowledges God’s holiness.

1 Thessalonians 1:1-10 Paul gives thanks for the faith of the Thessalonians to whom the gospel came not only in word but also in power and Spirit. They have turned from idols to worshipping “the living and true God” (v9)

“First Nations People got it Right”

Precis of AAM

In the 80’s film, “Crocodile Dundee”, a question is asked about whether the First Nations people own the land? The answer was, “They don’t own the land they belong to it; it is like a mother to them.” A coalition seeks to trap Jesus with a question about paying of taxes to Ceasar – even Rome belongs to God seemed to be the answer. The Aboriginal and Islander idea of who and what we belong to, seems most in line with the perspective of Jesus.
