**Jeremiah 17:5-10** Isaiah invites the listener to hear a collection of various sayings from the Lord, telling the people what he likes and dislikes and that each one will be treated according to the way he/she/they lives.

**Psalms 1** Provides a paradigmatic example of those who both embody God’s word (Torah) and are formed by it within the community of God’s people.

**1 Corinthians 15:12-20** Our Resurrection to come is because Christ was raised. Without that we would have nothing to believe. Our hope in Christ is not just good for this life.
