Discussion Starters

Readings for this day

Exodus 34:29-35 Moses returns from the mountaintop carrying two tablets of the law, his face shining with the encounter with God. The Israelites feared this. Moses veiled his face and unveiled it to return to the presence of God.

Psalm 99 This psalmist sings of the people trembling before God. God, enthroned on the holy mountain, is to be praised and exalted.

2 Corinthians 3:12-4:2 Through Christ we can to see the glory of God with unveiled faces. This glory is the glory that is our very transformation by the work of the Spirit of God.
