**Isaiah 50:4-9a**The speaker in this third servant song affirms the sure presence of God amid cruel and unjust treatment. Despite being insulted, spit upon, and physically struck, this faithful believer declares that God will soon declare he is innocent.

**Psalm 118:1-2, 19-29** The psalmist Jubilantly celebrates the salvation of God, and God's deliverance from death to life.

**Philippians 2:5-11** The ancient hymn gives witness both to the faithfulness of Christ and to the faithfulness of God. Jesus is the suffering servant whom God vindicates.
