2 Kings 2;1-2,6-14 Elijah departs, but God's Spirit comes upon Elisha in great power. The prophets are encouraged – the work of the Lord God of Israel will continue.

Psalm 77:1-2, 11-20 God's power in the service of God's people in ways that the very creation respects. Deep waters are not an obstacle when God leads the people along. The creation resects its Creator.

Luke 9:51-62 Jesus turns his face to Jerusalem and all that awaits him there. Having done so, his words on the cost of discipleship sharpen. What lies ahead is not for the half-hearted! To follow Jesus is to arrive finally at the cross.
