### Readings for this day

**Jeremiah 23:1-6** Jeremiah relays the judgement of God on the shepherds (i.e. rulers) who have led God's people astray. The blame for the exile is placed on these leaders. God will raise up a new Davidic king.

**Luke 1: 68-79** The song of Zechariah proclaims the coming of a Davidic ruler who will lead the people in the ways of peace.

**Colossians 1:11-20** Paul proclaims the supreme authority of Christ. Through his life and death, God reconciles and makes peace with all things in heaven and earth.
