Psalm 66: 8-20 Both communal and individual thanksgiving for deliverance, this psalm is a remembrance of God's help through every kind of difficulty.

Acts 17:22-31 Paul, after the stoning of Stephen, in Athens, bears witness to Christ in a very different context. Paul recites the story of Jesus offering a better hope.

1 Peter 3:13-22 Christ suffered to bring us to God, in the face of suffering the letter encourages the church to defend 'hope' when asked to speak about it.
